

MUSTER CERTIFICATES

If one considers what arrangements were made to defend the realm before the armed forces were set up, several questions arise:

- What was the King's answer to the task of raising an army?
- Who was in charge of selecting the men who were to serve?
- What arms did they need and how were they to be provided?
- How were the men selected and what records were kept?
- Are these records useful to the family historian?

Edward I tackled the problem in 1181 by organising Commissions of Array which raised armed forces in each shire whenever necessary. The commissioners appointed were usually barons, knights of the shire, or officers of the Royal Household. They were commanded to call up a certain number of men from each township, working from muster rolls prepared in each hundred. A century later, the Statute of Winchester in 1285 laid down what equipment each man between the ages of 15 and 60 had to bring with him, according to the value of the land or goods he owned. Typically the lesser landowners would have provided a sword and dagger, or a sword, bow and arrows and dagger; while a person owning land worth £15 and over or goods worth 40 marks and over would have had to provide a coat of mail, helmet, sword dagger and horse.

Twice a year a view of arms was held in each hundred. Any man required to serve abroad was paid wages, so the system allowed forces to be raised to cope with any emergency which might arise. The reference that I have used states that the commissioners were entered on the backs of Patent Rolls, reference C66 at the Public Record Office, but does not make clear if any lists of names are included with the commissions.

In Tudor times, the commission was replaced by the appointment of Lieutenants (later known as the Lord Lieutenant) in each shire. Acts of Parliament were passed in 1558 which modified each man's responsibilities for providing arms and also defined what a parish had to provide: guns, gunpowder and match, calivers, pikes, swords, corselets, head pieces and soldiers' coats. Ten separate classes of wealth were defined, the lowest class (those with incomes of between £5 - £10 a year) had to have a coat of plated armour, a steel cap, a longbow with arrows, and either a bill or a halberd. At the other end of the scale, men worth £1000 per year or more had to provide 16 horses, 80 suits of light armour, 40 pikes, 30 longbows, 20 bills or halberds, 20 arquebuses and 50 steel caps or helmets. In addition to the above rates, if a man's wife wore velvet kirtles or silk petticoats, he had to provide a light horse with its armour and harness!

From time to time, all the men liable for service were called, with their arms to muster. The purpose of the muster was to show off the men, horses and equipment. From 1570 men who were fit were given regular training. As a result, from that time, a Muster Certificate (which became known as a Muster Roll) distinguished between trained and untrained men and indicated to the county authorities who and what arms were available in each Hundred for the purposes of defence.

In normal times musters were held at least once every three years. In times of danger there might be two musters held in a year, or even more if it was thought necessary. Muster certificates were often badly written and some were never sent to the Secretary of State. Some show all healthy males between 16 and 60, others only trained men. The best returns, where they are extant, are said to be those for 1569 and 1573.

SOURCES

The sources for sixteenth century musters from 1522 onwards are scattered among various classes, including the State Papers (SP) at the Public Record Office, with others in class E101; and the Lansdowne MSS at the British Library. Gibson and Dell's book "Tudor and Stuart Muster Rolls" gives a county organised analysis and directory of holdings. After 1600, rolls can be found in the lieutenancy papers at county record offices, the British Library, and the Bodleian Library.

For the first nine years of James I's reign, musters and training fell into abeyance, but they were resumed in 1612 when a Spanish invasion was expected. A typical example of such a record is found in The Francis Green Manuscripts held at Haverfordwest Library. In Volume 27 there is a copy of a transcript of the Pembrokeshire Muster Books of 1613, made by Mr. Francis Jones. The original books are kept in the National Library of Wales, among the Bronwydd Documents.

An index has now been prepared for the listing in Volume 27 of the Francis Green Manuscripts. It has NOT been cross-referenced to the original papers, so researchers should NOT assume that there are no differences between the two listings, although any differences that occur should be minor.

Francis Green copied the manuscript in order of Hundred within Pembrokeshire as each hundred was composed in 1613, which is not as it is in the today. In addition, some small hamlets were separately listed in the hundreds, and some parishes were combined together.

Researchers should note that listings for Haverfordwest were NOT included in the copy made by Francis Green: presumably they were not included in the original papers. In addition, some other locations mentioned in the 1670 Hearth Tax are not mentioned in the Muster Roll for 1613 (e.g. Grondre, Haroldston West, etc.)

Many surnames in modern Pembrokeshire can be found in the Muster Roll:

Gollyns (is this Collins?), Folland, Jermyn and Saunders are among my interests, but Istance (of interest to member 168) also appears.

In Stuart times, when the more prosperous gentry raised their own volunteer forces, the beginnings of the Militia, and eventually the Armed Forces were set in train. After the Civil War, a standing army became a permanent feature of government, but there also existed a county based Militia. In 1757 the Militia Act introduced a form of conscription. Each year, the parish was supposed to draw up lists of adult males and to hold a ballot to choose those who were to serve in the militia. The militia lists include all men; and the militia enrolment lists shows the men chosen to serve. These two lists should in theory provide complete and annual censuses of all men between 18 and 45 from 1758 to 1831. If lists survive for Dyfed, they would fill an important gap in the records, giving a guide to continuity of ownership/ tenancy of lands and wealth.

AUTHOR'S NOTE

Researchers are advised that the problems encountered when indexing the Muster Books for 1613 mean that the index may be confusing to use, unless the next two pages are read carefully, prior to using it.

INTRODUCTION

The Francis Green Manuscripts contain many lists of Pembrokeshire folk, which are a valuable source of information on the owners/occupiers of property in Pembrokeshire. In particular, in Volume 27, there is a copy of a transcript made by Mr. Francis Jones of the Pembrokeshire Muster Books of 1613. The original books are kept in the National Library of Wales, among the Bronwydd Documents.

This index covers the photo-copied listing in Volume 27 held by Haverfordwest Reference Library. It has NOT been cross-referenced to the original papers, so researchers should NOT assume that there are no differences between the two listings, although any differences that occur should be minor.

Francis Green copied the manuscript in order of Hundred within Pembrokeshire as each hundred was composed in 1613, which is not as it is in the present day. In addition, some small hamlets were separately listed in the hundreds, and some parishes were combined together, so that while indexing by parish cover most of the transcript, using the accepted abbreviations for the parishes does not cover the whole transcript.

Researchers should note that listings for Haverfordwest were NOT included in the copy made by Francis Green: presumably they were not included in the original papers. In addition, some other locations mentioned in the 1670 Hearth Tax are not included in this listing (e.g. Grondre, Haroldston West, etc.)

PARISH CODES

The Parish codes used in this index are those used by Dyfed Family History Society in previous publications, with SOME EXCEPTIONS. The list below gives all codes used in this index for Pembrokeshire parishes as well as those used for Hamlets, etc. Alongside the codes is an indication of where in Volume 27 the Muster Roll listings will be found.

Some exceptions occur because the Society inadvertently repeated some abbreviations in two or more hundreds, hence I have had to use another code to avoid ambiguity. In some instances, parishes are mentioned twice in different parts of the listing, so to avoid confusion, all parish code references are included, even if no person was listed in the Muster.

All the codes used are the same as those used in an earlier index on The Hearth Tax, which was completed in 1992.

Alternative codes for duplications of codes used in the Dyfed Family History Society Listing are given with the relevant entries:-

- ** indicates modified use of code

Where there are no entries for the parish, this is indicated after the page number.

USING THE INDEX

I have continued Francis Green's practice of grouping the parishes into hundreds, because it shows the difference between surname groupings for those hundreds north and south of the 'Landsker'.

Surnames are given in capital letters in alphabetical order, followed by forenames, also in alphabetical order. Except for differentiating between "senior" and "junior" members of a family; no titles, occupations or other detail is given in the index. Surnames which could be phonetic variations of each other, for example: Rees, Rice, Reece etc., are listed separately.

A typical listing, found in that for the hundred of Castlemartin, shows:-

If you look up the list of three letter codes, you will establish that in Volume 27 of the Francis Green Manuscripts:-

William Kynney is in the listing for Angle parish, beginning on page 53

Philip Letch will be found in the listing for St. Twynells, on page 52

I have also included a surname index with these papers so that researchers can locate names of interest with little difficulty.
